

## **Seeley Lake Refuse District Garbage Disposal Charges:** **As of: July 30, 2009**

Following are the amounts charged to customers at the Seeley Lake Transfer Site. [Blue denotes new charge amounts.](#)

### **Out of District refuse:**

Anyone residing out of the Refuse District wishing to use our facility, may do so but must pay [\\$26.00 per yard for deposited waste](#) to the site attendant. A receipt will be offered.

### **Volume equivalents:**

One 32 gallon garbage can is equivalent to 1/8<sup>th</sup> of a compacted yard.

One 32 gallon trash bag cost is [\\$3.00](#) for all out of district users.

One (4 x 8 ft) truck box level full of household refuse is one cubic yard

One (4 x 8 ft) truck box level full of construction materials is 2 cubic yards

### **Costs for disposal:**

One cubic yard of household refuse or construction material is [\\$15.00.](#)

[Dump Trucks \(any material\), \\$26.00/yd.](#)

### **Appliances:**

Appliances having no freon: \$5.00. Refrigerators/freezers with freon: \$35.00.

### **Furniture:**

Chairs: \$5.00 each, Sofas: \$10.00 each, [Hide-a-bed: \\$15.00 each, Mattresses: \\$5.00 each, Box spring: \\$5.00 each.](#)

### **Tires:**

Passenger car/truck tires: [\\$3.00 each](#), semi-truck tires: [\\$6.00 each](#), large tractor tires: [\\$15.00 each.](#)

### **Burnable materials:**

Items classified as "burnable" by the site attendants may be added to the burn pile at the site. Fees are: small truck: [\\$5.00 load](#), large truck: [\\$10.00 to \\$15.00 load](#), dump truck: [\\$30.00 load.](#)

### **Items that may be deposited for no charge:**

1. Items that are recyclable, includes any item defined as "blue bag" items.
2. Cardboard
3. Scrap metal which is deposited in the scrap metal bin.

Mingling of Class 2 and Class 3 materials is not allowed:

Class 3 materials may not be included with Class 2 materials and put in the 40-yard bins. ALL Class 3 materials, dirt, rocks, soil and concrete may not be deposited in the bins, but must be separated and deposited in the Class 3 site.

Class 3 disposal site materials:

Broken concrete, stumps, dirt and soil will be deposited in the "Class 3 Disposal Site" as directed by the Site Attendant. Anything deposited there will be charged normal disposal charges of \$10.00 per cubic yard.

Hazardous Materials not allowed at the Transfer Site:

Batteries:

Includes, automobile, motorcycle, ATV charger/jumpstart packs that contain batteries. These materials can be deposited at the NAPA or Parts Plus stores in Seeley Lake.

Paint:

All paints and stain, except dried latex paint must be disposed of at the Missoula City disposal site.

Oil:

We do not accept oil of any kind. This includes radiator anti-freeze, etc.

Propane tanks:

Propane tanks may be disposed of at Cenex on North Reserve Street in Missoula.
