TO: Residents and Customers
of the Solid Waste District (Trash Transfer Site)

Since May of last year Larson Disposal has been dumping your solid waste trash at the Seeley Lake Transfer Site on Woodworth Road rather than hauling the trash directly to the Missoula landfill. Both the Seeley Lake Transfer Site and the Missoula landfill have a fee assessment for dumped trash based on yardage volume. It has always been the policy and the practice at the Seeley Lake Transfer Site to bill customers directly for the volume yardage of trash dumped, regardless of who actually transports the trash to the site. This practice will be changing effective July 1st of this year, when Larson Disposal will be billed directly for yardage dumped at the site, and these fees will be passed on to you via billing from Larson Disposal.

While all taxpayers within the district will continue to receive a 10 cubic yard credit for their annual tax assessment, all residential trash must be brought to the site outside of a commercial dumpster. For those customers utilizing Larson Disposal and who routinely place their residential trash in a commercial dumpster, such yardage will be billed monthly. In order to not be billed for residential yardage within the 10 yard allotment, customers must separate residential trash from commercial trash. Residential trash mixed with commercial business trash will be charged yardage rates.

The following rates will be effective July 1, 2009:

- ❖ In-district yardage fees at \$15 per yard
- ❖ Out-of-district yardage fees at \$26 per yard
- ❖ Burn-site materials chargeable at sliding scale \$5-\$10-\$15
- ❖ Tires chargeable at sliding scale \$3-\$6-\$15
- ❖ Furniture chargeable at sliding scale \$5-\$10-\$15
- ❖ Appliances without Freon \$5; Appliances with Freon \$35
- ❖ Construction materials (in-district) at \$15 per yard
- ❖ Class 3 (concrete, stumps, soil) chargeable at \$10 per yard
- ❖ No charge for recycling: blue bag items (aluminum, plastics, papers, etc), cardboard, scrap metal
Free blue bags available at the site or at the Chamber of Commerce Office in the Barn Visitor's Center
- ❖ Hazardous materials (auto batteries, paint, oil, propane tanks, etc) are not allowed at the transfer site; contact site manager for disposal resources

Transfer site is located at off Woodworth Road near Salmon Lake. Summer site hours: Wed 9-7; Sat & Sun 9-5
